7. KAREN RAE KRAUT *STORYTELLING*

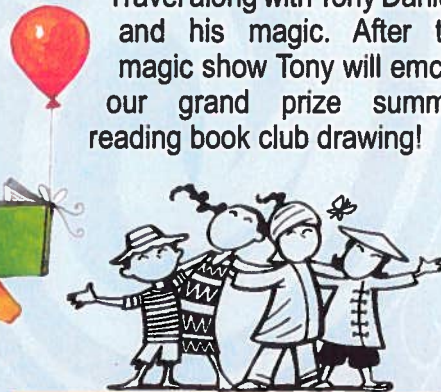
Wednesday, July 27, 3 – 4 p.m.

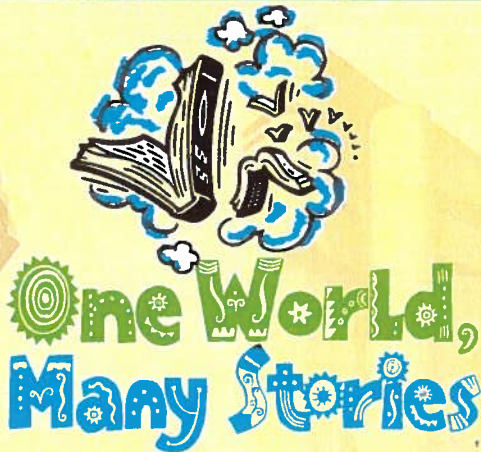

How to participate (Children under age 12):

1. Sign-up begins Monday June 13th. Register at the Children's Desk and receive your own book bag, reading log, pencil and book mark.
2. Keep track of the books you read by listing them on your reading log.
3. Once you have read five books, you will receive a free book of your choice to keep and a raffle ticket. For every five books you read after that, you will receive an additional raffle ticket for the weekly drawing held after the show each Wednesday afternoon.

All raffle tickets must be received by library staff on or before 12 noon, Wednesday, August 3, 2011.



How to participate (Young adults age 12 and older)

1. Sign-up begins Monday June 13th. Register at the Children's Desk and receive your own book bag, reading log, pencil, book mark and book review form.
2. Keep track of the chapter books you read by listing them on your reading log.
3. After each chapter book you read, complete a short book review on the form provided by the library. After you complete your first book review, you will receive a free paperback book of your choice, as well as a raffle ticket for the weekly drawing.
4. For each chapter book you read and review, you will receive another raffle ticket for the weekly drawing.

Participants are eligible to win one weekly prize. All raffle tickets are placed in the grand prize drawing held on Wednesday, August 3.
